





## School Visits to our farm

Our School Visit days are highly organised and very structured, commencing at 10.30am prompt, with all activities completed by 2.00pm with a lunch break from 12.00 - 12.45pm approx.

Although we have our own highly trained staff, it is important that there are enough staff with the school party to ensure that the children get the most from their day at the farm park.

Children are divided into groups of approximately 20 (the exact number of groups required will have been highlighted in the confirmation sent to the school).

Each group participates in an activity which takes approx. 30 minutes and is then directed onto the next activity by our staff.

## Activities you can expect to do:

- \* Weighing/Mixing/Preparing lamb or calf milk and then feeding.
- A paddock walk discussing trees/animal homes/animals in the paddock.
  - Egg Collecting Counting eggs, opening an egg and discussing contents, then handling baby chicks.
  - Looking at/discussing our pigs and piglets/ guinea pig handling
    - Tractor Ride
    - > Play session



Price - The price is £9.00 per child with one adult admitted free for every 5 children - additional adults are charged at £7.00 each. Once a booking has been confirmed by ourselves, any cancellation must be paid in full.

What to wear - All children and staff must have clothing and footwear suitable for a farm visit, with no open toe sandals or flip flops.

Payment - Payment must be made at the end of the visit and we would ask that you please take all picnic waste away with you. Up to 5 absent children will not be charged, but any above this number will need to be paid for.
